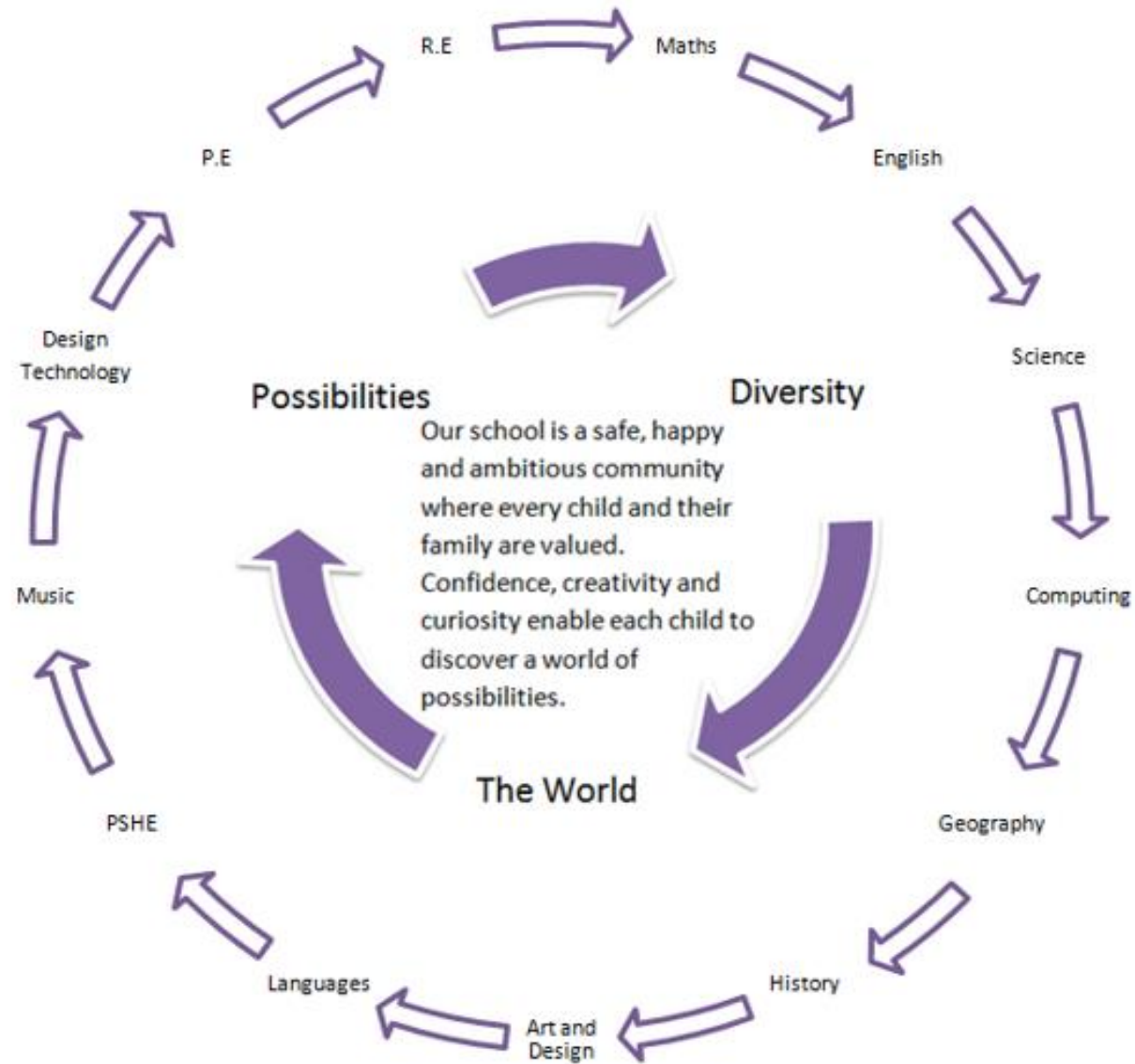


Living and Learning Together

Through Science, our pupils will be inspired and curious about the world around them and develop enquiring minds, that prepare them for modern life.



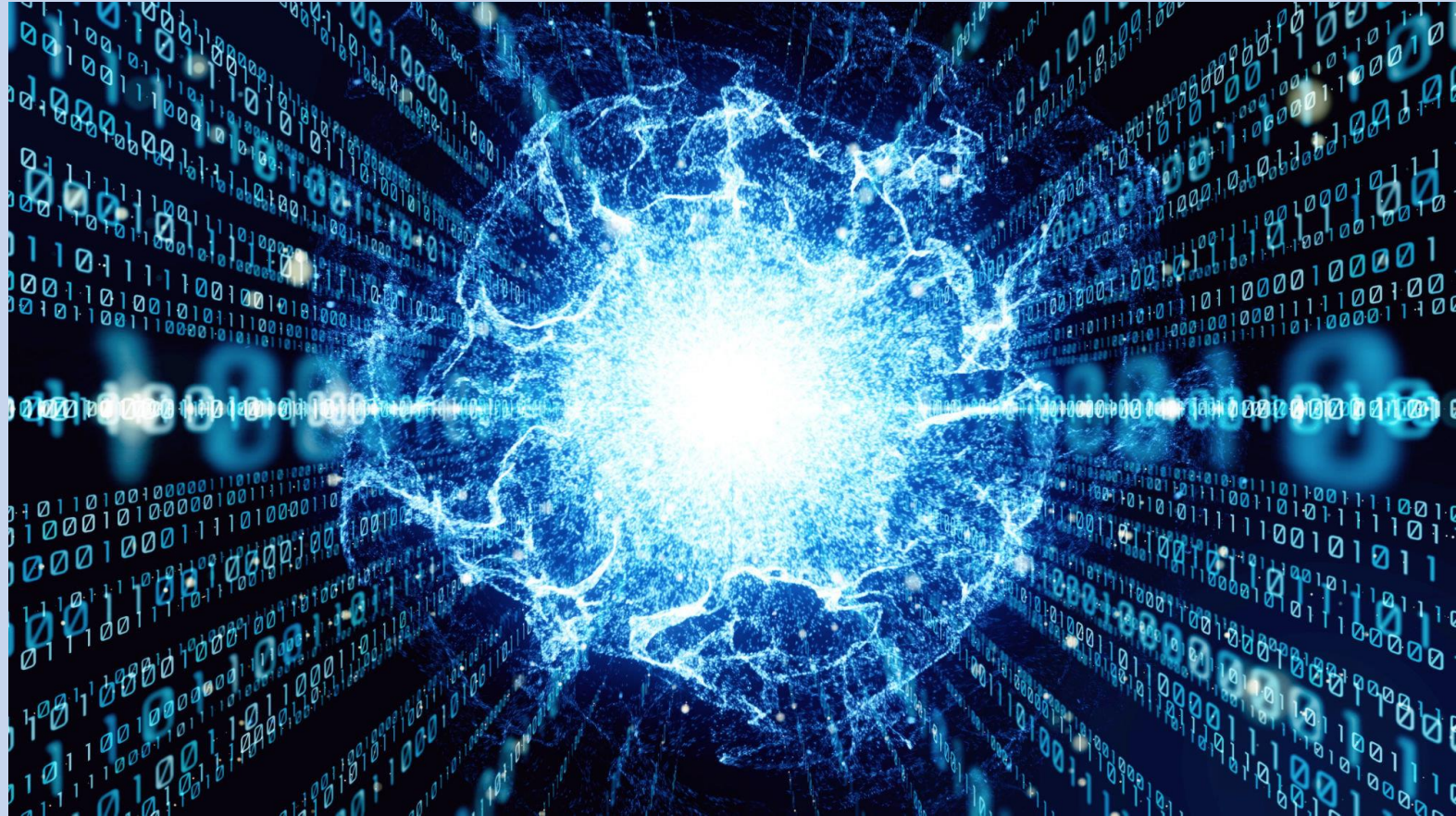
Design Technology
